N.M.W rates from Oct.15

Apprentice Rate: 16-18 and 19+ and within 1st

year: **£3.30p/h** 

Staff **NOT** on an Apprenticeship:

16-17 = £3.87 p/hour 18-20 = £5.30 p/hour

21 and over = **£6.70** p/hour

Employers do no longer have to pay NIC on any apprentice aged under 25 as of April 2016.
